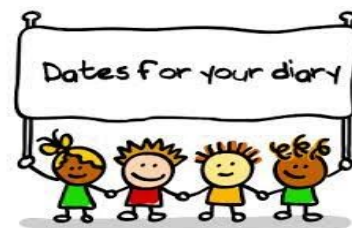
The attendance winners this week are Year 6 with 99.3% Well
