It will be a tough week for everyone but we are definitely prepared.

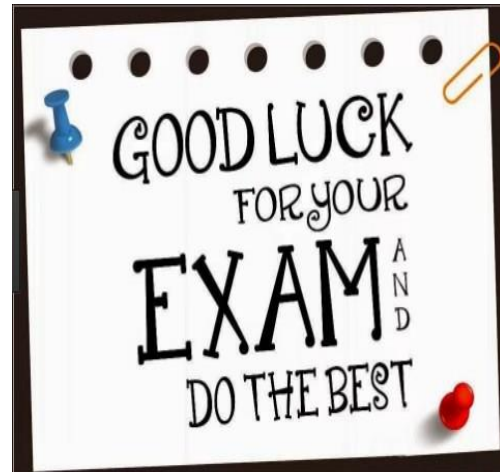
This is the order of the Year 6 SATs :
