

Allocation of PE and Sports Premium Funding (Academic Year 2017- 2018)

This year, the school was allocated £14 185 PE and Sport Premium grant. A large portion of our funding has been spent by purchasing the services of SJD Sports.

Priorities for funding for 2017/2018 are:

- Deliver quality first teaching in PE as part of broad and balanced curriculum
- Develop staff expertise in teaching in gymnastics, dance and invasion games skills, through providing additional training and professional development and covering classes to enable teachers to do this.
- Increase participation in sport through the provision of lunchtime and after school clubs
- Increase participation in local Learning Community and county-wide competitions and tournaments
